Please note that we do not knowingly "sell" or "share" the personal information of any individuals under the age of 18.

Right to Limit Use of Sensitive Personal Information: Residents of certain states may have the right to request that we limit the use of any sensitive personal information to those uses which are necessary to perform our services or for other specifically enumerated business purposes under the CCPA, as amended by the CPRA, or other state statute. Once your request is verified and we have determined that we are required to delete the requested

Your request to delete personal information may be denied if we conclude it is necessary for us to retain such personal information under one or more of the exceptions listed in the CCPA, or other state statute.

Residents of certain states have the right to request that we correct any inaccurate personal information we maintain about you, considering the nature of the personal information and the purposes for which we are processing such personal information. We will use commercially reasonable efforts to correct such inaccurate personal information about you.
